

Al Investment

Silicon Valley outspend everyone and what that means:

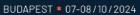
- Inflection \$1.5bn no income bought by Microsoft
- Anthropic approx. \$1.8bn between costs and sales (Google and Amazon have put in \$7bn)
- Microsoft reports \$1bn in sales from AI but paid \$16m + Azure resources for a stake in Mistral and invested \$13bn in Open AI (plus additional \$6.6bn with others last week)
- Meta spending \$10bn in one year for returns in the future.
- Google paid \$2.7bn for CharacterAl

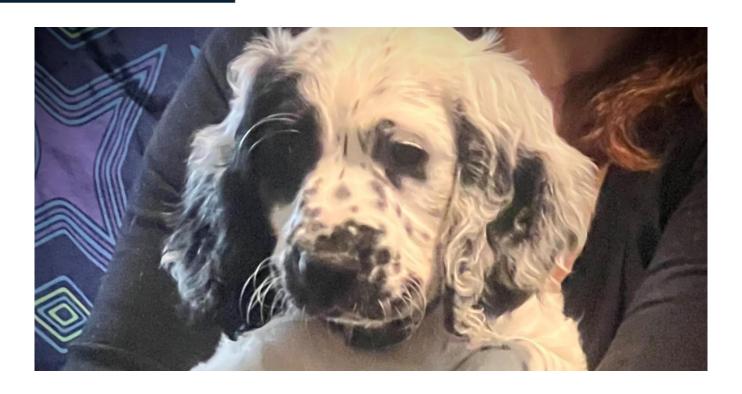
Entrepreneurs

GPT4.o outperformed GPT3.5;GPT4o-v; Mixtral

OU, BBC, Reuters Study

Denmark, UK, Argentina, USA, France & Japan – 12000 people. May '24

- Large proportion used Al Chatbots "once or twice".
- 7% in the US, 2% in the UK said they use ChatGPT "on a daily basis". Much smaller recognition of any other tool
- In all countries (including 47% in the US, and 42% in the UK) some hadn't even heard of ChatGPT

OU, BBC, Reuters Study

Two categories of use:

- "creating media" most said they were simply "playing around or experimenting" (11%), "writing an email or letter" (9%) or "making an image" (9%).
- "getting information' = "answering factual questions" (11%) and "asking advice" (10%) raises the hallucination question!

- Microsoft and Google 2023 sustainability targets

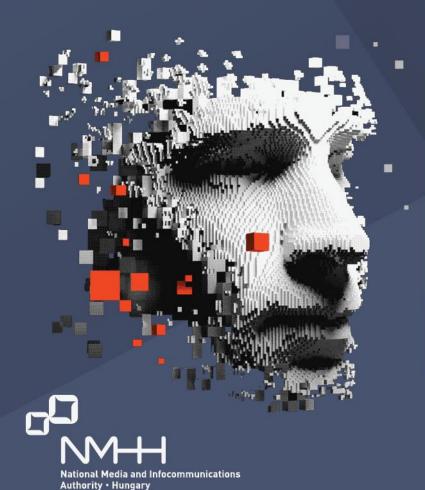
